Want to be trained as a Circle Keeper?

Yes! ... if you're interested in restorative justice practices that can be used to resolve conflicts, address issues and provide a space for healing and healthy communication. Circles are used with youth and families involved in the criminal justice system, to resolve conflicts and address issues in schools, communities, and workplace settings.
